Below is for Windows 10 or Windows 7. Oracle Java will work on a 32bit or 64bit system.

Step 1

Install Oracle Java

Step 4

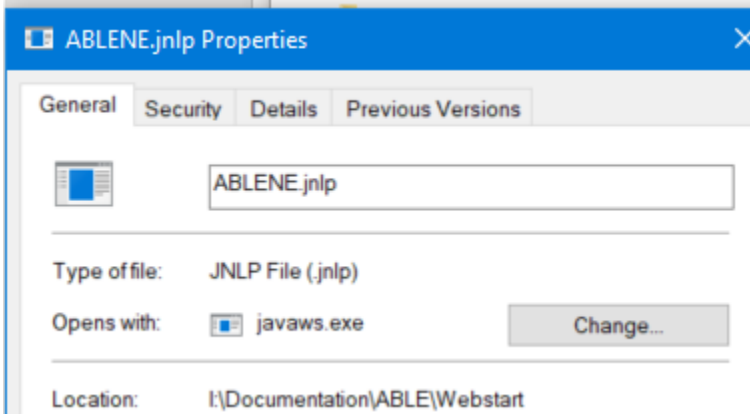
Reboot your computer

Step 5

Run your JNLP file by clicking your link OR by double clicking on the JNLP file on your desktop.

You should see the Java loading window before the Java application starts up. If you do NOT see the window:

1. Right click on your JNLP file and choose Properties
2. Make sure Open With says javaws.exe



3. If it does not Select Change
4. Browse to: C:\Program Files\Java\jdk1.8.0_291\bin OR something similar in the window that opens and choose javaws.exe and click Open
